Come on out and show your fine example of our favorite Stuttgart machinery, and support the Youth Service Bureau!



Montreal round of the Formula 1 World Championship



Dan and Cherish Crust attended the Montreal round of the Formula 1 World Championship on June 11-13. All three days were action-packed and the whole city was busy with F1 excitement. In addition to the F1 cars, there were support races in Formula 1600, Ferrari Challenge (should've been Porsche Cup!), and Historic Grand Prix Cars. F1 qualifying was exciting with Lewis Hamilton/McLaren taking pole with his final lap as the last man on track. The race itself was thrilling from start to finish with multiple pit stops



and numerous passes on track. We were on the inside of the hairpin, with cars decelerating through six gear changes from about

180 mph down to about 40, the accelerating back toward us on the longest straight, hitting fifth gear just after they went by us. Hamilton came out on top, with teammate and reigning World Champion Jenson Button 2nd, and Fernando Alonso 3rd for Ferrari. Interestingly, it was the first podium with three World Champions since the US Grand Prix in 1991. Cherish's favorite driver, Heikki Kovalainen, put in a great drive for the resurrected Team Lotus, who are really developing well. The track was opened to the fans as soon as the race ended, and we spent a couple hours soaking up the atmosphere as we walked the track. The whole experience was great, and we would recommend it to any road racing fan. Montreal is only about 9 hours driving time, with great scenery en route, a great city at the end, and fantastic racing at the circuit.
